Respiratory worldwide is a monthly column in which authors from national and regional respiratory organisations share their latest news and views, providing an overview of the activities and events in the global respiratory community.

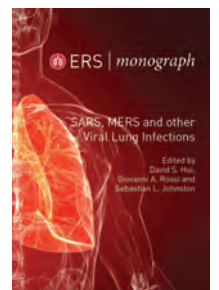
